BETWEEN THE ROAD AND THE DITCH, WHAT WE WILL PICK UP:

Sheetrock, Lumber, Furniture, Carpeting/Flooring, Clothing/Fabric

WE WILL NOT PICK UP ANY DEBRIS BEHIND THE DITCH IN THE YARD OR THE FOLLOWING:

Hazardous Waste/Chemicals, Appliances, Electronics/Computers, Green Tree Parts, Grass Clippings, Yard Waste

Appliances, Limbs, Yard Waste and Tires will be picked up at a later date.
